Flex-Fit Boat Cover

IMPORTANT: The first time you install your cover, make sure that your boat is clean.

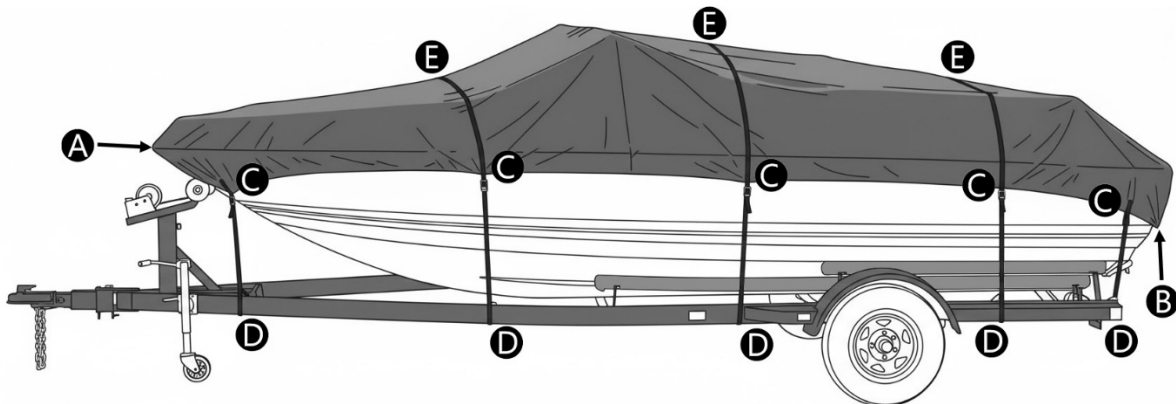
In the event a return is necessary, restocking fees are waived for items returned in like-new condition without any dirt or stains.

CONTENTS:

Boat cover, Mesh storage bag, Set of **Short** Straps with Male/Female connector, Set of **Long**, anti-lofting straps with Male/Male connector. Note: Included strap count varies slightly based on cover dimensions.

GENERAL:

- Clean and dry your boat before installation if it is dirty. Never cover a wet and dirty boat.
- We recommend removing the cover every 30 days to air out.
- Supports (sold separately) are required to prevent water/ice from accumulating on top of the cover.
- Max trailering speed is 60-65 mph. ALL straps must be used.



DIRECTIONS

BEFORE YOU BEGIN: PREPARE THE BOAT, COVER, AND ACCESSORIES

- Install supports and cover stress points and sharp edges for protection.
- Remove or securely tie down any detachable accessories. Bimini tops must be laid down.
- Separate tie down straps into **short** straps (male/female clips) and **long** straps (male/male clips).

INSTALLATION:

1. Locate the "Front" label and position at the bow [A]. Pull any excess fabric to the stern [B].
2. Adjust individual support poles at this time if needed.
3. Locate a tie-down loop on the cover hemline [C]. Thread a short strap through this loop, down around the trailer frame (D), and back up to secure.
4. Locate an attached female clip at the cover hemline [C] and connect a long strap (male/male). Thread the long strap through the two guide loops on the cover exterior (top) [E] and secure to the other side.

CAUTION: These long straps are NOT designed for use as a belly strap. Proper installation of these straps is REQUIRED for travel use. These straps keep the cover contoured to your boat during travel.

CARE AND CLEANING	<p>Use a soft/medium bristle brush (dry) or dry sponge to remove loose dirt and debris from the cover surface. Do not pressure wash or dry clean.</p> <p>For more extensive dirt/soilage</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Cover may be sponge cleaned in the soiled area, or machine washed on gentle. 2. CAUTION: DO NOT USE DETERGENT OR CHEMICALS TO CLEAN! 3. Use cold water only. 4. Air dry or line dry only. <p>To avoid mildew be sure your cover is completely dry before you store it.</p>
